- 5) If you answered yes to Q.3, when do the contracts end?
- 6) Do you have a procurement planned for the provision of water and waste water investigation and/or repair in the next two years?
- 7) If you answered yes to Q.6, when is this process planned for commencement?
- 8) Who is the decision maker pertaining to water and waste water pipework investigation and/or repair within your organisation?
- 9) How much did your organisation spend on water and waste water pipework replacement in the past 12 months (or the most recent completed 12 months)
- 10) What provider(s) did your organisation use for water and waste water pipework replacement in the past 12 months (or the most recent completed 12 months)
- 11) Do you hold a contract with a supplier or suppliers of water and waste water pipework replacement?
- 12) If you answered yes to Q.11, who are the contracts with?
- 13) If you answered yes to Q.11, when do the contracts end?
- 14) Do you have a procurement planned for the provision of water and waste water replacement in the next two years?

- 16) Who is the decision maker pertaining to water and waste water pipework replacement within your organisation?

- 17) How much did your organisation spend on lead service pipe replacement in the past 12 months (or the most recent completed 12 months)
- 18) What provider(s) did your organisation use for lead service pipe replacement in the past 12 months (or the most recent completed 12 months)
- 19) Do you hold a contract with a supplier or suppliers lead service pipe replacement?
- 20) If you answered yes to Q.19, who are the contracts with?
- 21) If you answered yes to Q.19, when do the contracts end?
- 22) Do you have a procurement planned for the provision of lead service pipe replacement in the next two years?
- 23) If you answered yes to Q.22, when is this process planned for commencement?
- 24) Who is the decision maker pertaining to lead service pipe replacement within your organisation?

Where you are not satisfied with the response to a request for information that falls within the Environmental Information Regulations, you should make a representation for a review to FOI Appeals Officer, sthelensccg.foi@nhs.net within 40 days of receipt of the response.

If you are not satisfied with our review under the Freedom of Information Act or the Environmental Information Regulations, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) for a review of your appeal decision. Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted our complaints procedure.
